Submission Guidelines

Submitted papers are required to be 6-16 pages in English (one page approximating A5 size, i.e. about 800 words), and using the MFOI templates which can be found on the page <http://mfoi2020.inf.ua/papersubmission.html>.

The submissions should have a succinct statement of the problem, obtained results, their significance and a comparison with previous works (if any), as well as a list of references. The submissions should also include the title of the proposed paper, author's names, affiliations, addresses, the name of an author to contact for a possible correspondence, the e-mail address of the contact author, and topics which best describe the paper (max. 5 keywords).

All accepted papers will be published after the conference in the Proceedings of MFOI'2020.
